An Update from Lisa Thomas

Hello everyone,

I have been asked to do the introduction for the Parish News this week so I am taking the opportunity to reflect a little on my experience as a chaplain to the Law Courts in Winchester.

One of the things you notice immediately is that there is a lot of activity in

the corridors. People arriving, barristers talking, court staff rushing. All very active. But there is also a lot of waiting around too,

If you have never been into a Crown Court before it can be quite bewildering and disorientating. If you go into the public galleries you can often hear distressing cases – it is a Crown Court so deals with serious cases – which can be quite shocking.

Chaplains offer non-judgemental, confidential listening to everybody involved in the life of the courts of whatever faith or non. We are not there to convert people or fill churches, though we do speak about our faith if asked.

So where is God in all of this? One of the lessons I have learned is that I don't take God with me into the Law Courts, he is already there. My calling is to discern where he is working in the lives of the people I talk to. Chaplaincy is above all an incarnational ministry, showing through being there that God loves and values the people I meet and talk with. It is about is being alongside people and loving them. Not always easy but very humbling.
